Veltus Park Ribbon Cutting and Volunteer Day

GLENWOOD SPRINGS, CO – The City of Glenwood Springs invites community members to celebrate the completion of the Veltus Park Shoreline Restoration Project on October 20, 2018 from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

This event will begin with a ribbon cutting ceremony by City officials to mark the completion of the shoreline restoration construction project. Following the ribbon cutting, community members are invited to volunteer their time and help with the final plantings of the project.

Mayor Mike Gamba stated “This is a wonderful opportunity to officially show off the new shoreline at Veltus Park. As a council priority, it’s satisfying to see this important project completed. Veltus is one of Glenwood Springs’ most beloved parks and it will be especially meaningful for the community to participate in the plantings that will endure for decades to come.”

The City will provide tools, gloves, water, and lunch to volunteers. This is a kid-friendly event and families are encouraged to attend.

Shoreline restoration work at Veltus Park was completed to prevent future erosion at the park from the Roaring Fork River. Construction included the removal of previous concrete walkways, debris, and railings while adding new railings and improved river access.
