



2016 River Commission Priorities/Goals

Action Items

1. Organize a river cleanup and community picnic to take place July 30. Patrick Murphy will lead.
2. Continue to advocate for cleaning up the old wastewater treatment plant site for use as a temporary park.
3. Actively work with the City Council during the formalization of stormwater treatment standards. Develop a public awareness campaign on stormwater and non-point-source pollution.
4. Inventory existing river access points and make recommendations for improvements and/or additional access opportunities. Organize a field trip utilizing bikes and boats to gain input for the inventory.
5. Continue to work for construction of uncompleted parts of the River Trail Masterplan. Decide which segments should be done next.
6. Advocate approval of the Wulfsohn Mountain Park Master Plan by City Council. Pursue opportunities to promote this park.
7. Participate in development of a new commercial-only boat ramp on the Roaring Fork near Glenwood Springs High School.
8. Continue to participate in the drive to re-authorize the Acquisitions and Improvement Tax, which is the source of funding for the River Trail System.

Items to monitor

1. Completion of design work and pursuit of funding for shoreline improvements at Two Rivers Park and Veltus Park, including construction of an interim boat ramp expansion.
2. Compliance with agreements between the City of Glenwood Springs and the Hot Springs Lodge and Pool regarding the HSP's new outfall drain at Two Rivers Park.
3. Construction of the bike path connecting the Meadows commercial development with I-70 Interchange 114.
