City of Glenwood Springs Arts and Culture Board Meeting of February 18, 2020 6:00 PM Glenwood Springs Community Center

3. Citizen Comments:
 - a. None
4. Approval of November and December Minutes
 - a. Mary made a motion to approve, Bonnie second. All in favor, none opposed.
5. The Angel of Hope Mosaic Project - Diane Orlov (founder and lead artist), Heather Hicks (board member), Michael Fuller (board member, architect)
 - a. Diane's inspiration was her work at the children's hospital in Tampa on another angel mosaic that provided sense of shelter and immortality for the children. She lost her own daughter 5 years ago. Believes no one fights a battle alone, there are angels all around. This piece will be a Latina angel displaying a strong sense of female power. The angel will be composed of individual mosaics made by people in the community symbolizing peace, healing, and hope. There will be a book to accompany the project with details to tell the story and explain artistic vision.
 - b. Architectural design – Mosaic to be mounted on durable shower backer board, insulated from the weather, and lit. Concrete site will be wrapped with gardens and benches.
 - c. Location – On St. Stephen property between the church and the school, facing east towards Valley View hospital.
 - d. Project is non-profit with fiscal sponsor.
 - e. What can the ACB do for the group?
 - i. Take a tour and see the angel.

- ii. Provide a letter of support for the FAB Grant through City of Glenwood Springs.
 - 1. Construction of site and installation of art piece estimated to be \$100k.
 - 2. Artist's and assistant(s) fee estimated to be \$75k.
 - 3. Valley View and St. Stephens are not currently donating funds.
 - 4. Bryana made a motion that the Arts and Culture Board craft a letter of support for the FAB Grant application. Bonnie second. All in favor, none opposed.
 - a. Stefanie asked for information regarding the amount of funding obtained so far, who from, etc. from Heather so she can draft a letter.
- iii. Information on other grant sources for arts?
 - 1. Garfield County
 - 2. In-kind donations from the contractor(s) involved
 - 3. Shelley will mention this project to Ashley, the City's grant writer, to keep her eye out for similar grants
 - 4. Cancer support group
- iv. How could this fit into the City's developing art plan? Could this be included on any art mapping?
 - 1. Depending on the implementation of the Art Plan, this may be considered.
- f. What is the timeline?
 - i. Initially hoped to complete it by this fall, restricted by funding and the building addition timing at St. Stephens.
 - ii. Angel is about 6 months out on artwork completion.
 - iii. Realistically, could be spring 2021.
- g. Who is working on the design of the angel?
 - i. A culmination of people from the community have contributed to the angel's design.
 - ii. Stefanie asked the group to be cognizant of cultural representation since the angel is Latina – has Latino/a input been received?
- h. Who will maintain the piece after installation?
 - i. The grounds keeper of St. Stephens, Aldo.
- i. Is there a back-up plan if the whole amount needed isn't raised in time? Place on new building's wall instead, etc. Could be plus when presented to council.
 - i. Diane – Possibly installing pieces as a walking path instead along the Rio Grande.
 - ii. Shelley's thought – steppingstones instead of benches for memorials.
