Two Rivers Park closure to begin Monday, October 7 for construction of the boat ramp and river walk project

GLENWOOD SPRINGS, CO – The City of Glenwood Springs will close Two Rivers Park for riverfront improvement construction on Monday, October 7 and will remain closed through April 2020. The closure includes the entire park and the boat ramp on the Colorado River.

Heyl Construction as been selected for the riverfront improvements project which includes: excavation of the in-river railroad abutment and industrial debris along the park's shoreline, installation of a river walk trail, protection of beach areas, an improved boat ramp and staging area, ADA connectivity, restrooms for river users, and landscaping along the riverfront.

During the closure, pedestrians and cyclists will not be able to enter the park from the Rio Grande Trail pedestrian bridge and will be redirected to 6th Street. River users should plan accordingly for the closure and take out at other ramp locations in the area.
